

VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE ORDINANCE # 2013-02

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 9.40.030 OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE VILLAGE OF CAMBRIDGE RELATING TO TRUANCY

The Village Board of the Village of Cambridge, Dane and Jefferson Counties, does hereby ordain as follows:

Chapter 9.40.030.C., Municipal Code shall be created to read as follows:

C. Contribution to Truancy.

1. No person seventeen (17) years of age or older shall, by an act or omission, knowingly encourage or contribute to the truancy of a person seventeen (17) years of age or under. This prohibition shall not apply to a person who has under his or her control a child who has been sanctioned under Sec. 49.26(1)(h), Wis. Stats. An act or omission contributes to the truancy of a child, whether or not the child is adjudged to be in need of protection or services, if the natural and probably consequences of that act or omission would be to cause the child to be a truant.
2. Any person found to have violated subsection C.1. of this Chapter shall be subject to a forfeiture pursuant to Section 1.16.010 of this code.

All other provisions of Chapter 9.40.030, Municipal Code, shall remain the same.

The Village Board DOES FURTHER ORDAIN that this Ordinance shall be effective following its adoption and publication.
