RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF A 2015 CAMBRIDGE FOUNDATION DONATION FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF THE CAMBRIDGE COMMUNITY LIBRARY

WHEREAS, library services are greatly valued by Village citizens and citizens throughout this area, and;

WHEREAS, the Cambridge Foundation, a treasured community organization, established in 1947, has a successful history of planning and executing plans to make the Cambridge area a better place to live with a program of progress for the area, and;

WHEREAS, to date many citizens and organizations, including the Village of Cambridge and the Cambridge Foundation, have generously supported the construction of a new Cambridge Community Library donating or pledging over \$1.9 million for a facility to serve the community for decades to come, and;

WHEREAS, in 2014 construction costs increased due to the need to protect wetlands abutting the site with corresponding time delays causing winter construction leading to the requirement for additional funds to complete the project, said funds being sought from multiple sources.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Cambridge Village Board of Trustees, that it hereby supports a request to the Cambridge Foundation for a 2015 donation of \$150,000 to bring the "final chapter" of the library construction project to a successful conclusion, benefiting current and future generations of area residents.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Cambridge Village Board of Trustees, that it thanks the Cambridge Foundation for its sixty-seven years of active generosity making our community a great place to live, work and raise a family.

This resolution was duly considered and adopted by the Village Board by a unanimous vote on this 25th day of November 2014.
